• Depart Commission Hearing on the Queen Mary in Long Beach

11:00 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.

• Proceed to Santa Monica Mountains, exiting 101 fwy at Las Virgenes Road.

1st Stop—Approximately 12:15 p.m.

Mulholland Highway Overlook (Mulholland Highway just east of Stokes Canyon Road)

Commission to view examples of oak woodlands and chaparral habitats

12:15 – 1:15 pm

- Continue east on Mulholland Hwy. to Cold Canyon Road and turn right (south) to Piuma Road to Malibu Canyon Road.
- Drive through Malibu Canyon

Commission to view examples of oak woodlands, small lot subdivision development, and Malibu Creek State Park

2nd Stop—Approximately 1:15 p.m.

Malibu Bluffs Park (Malibu Canyon Road at Pacific Coast Highway)

Commission to stop for lunch at Malibu Bluffs Park. Brief presentation on future plans for Malibu Bluffs Park by Russ Guiney, Superintendent, California Department of Parks and Recreation.

2:15 –3:00 p.m.

- Proceed west along Pacific Coast Highway to City limits
- Turn around at Leo Carrillo State Park

Commission to view coastal sage scrub, and riparian habitats, canyons, developed areas of higher and lower density, public beaches, and public parkland along the route.

3rd Stop—Approximately 2:45 p.m.

Nicholas Canyon County Beach (Pacific Coast Highway)

Commission to view examples of riparian habitat, bluff habitat, public beach.

4th Stop—Approximately 3:15 p.m.

Point Dume Natural Preserve

Brief stop at parking area on Cliffside Drive at Point Dume State Preserve

Commission to view the preserve and public parking area.

• Proceed east on Pacific Coast Highway to Malibu Civic Center

5th Stop—Approximately 3:45 p.m.
