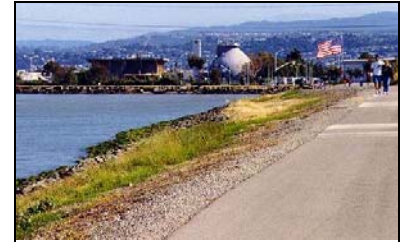


**DESCRIPTION**

San Mateo Creek flows from the Peninsula watershed through the Lower Crystal Springs Reservoir at Crystal Springs Dam, through Hillsborough and San Mateo out to San Francisco Bay. The watershed provides wildlife habitat and fish spawning habitat, including preservation of rare and endangered species. Potential uses also include water recreation. The Crystal Springs Lower Peninsula’s watershed is also used for municipal and domestic water supply.
