

CCD Drawing Rules

1. In order to be eligible to enter the CCD Drawing, entrants:
Must be 13 years or over;

Must be a U.S. citizen.
2. Only one prize may be awarded per household.
3. No purchase necessary to enter or win.
4. The contest is void where prohibited.
5. In case of a dispute as to the identity of an entrant using the Internet, the authorized account holder of the email address used to enter the Drawing at the time of entry will be considered the entrant.
6. California Coastal Commissioners and staff and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.
7. Sponsors are not responsible for any problems with your entry, including technical failures related to computer, telephone, cable, and unavailable network or server connections, or other failures related to hardware, software or virus, or incomplete, late or misdirected entries.
8. If the Coastal Commission is unable to make contact by email with prize winner within one week, another winner will be selected.
9. Acceptance of a prize constitutes the winner's consent to publicize his or her name and city in connection with the Ecoplates Drawing.
10. Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any person tampering with the operation or conduct of the CCD Drawing, including, without limitation, the entry process or the operation of the web site or otherwise violating these rules.
11. Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, terminate or modify any of the CCD Drawings if it cannot be operated, conducted or completed as planned, for any reason.
12. Prizes listed may be substituted for other first prizes of equal value, based on availability.

CCD Drawing Privacy Policy

Personal information provided in conjunction with entering a CCD drawing (“Personal Information”) will be collected solely for the purpose of selecting winners of the CCD drawing and for periodic communication about upcoming events, if the entrant opts to receive such emails. An entrant may request at any time that his or her Personal Information be discarded without reuse or distribution by contacting coast4u@coastal.ca.gov.

Survey Gizmo is used to collect entries for our prize drawings. Survey Gizmo's privacy policy forbids the use (or trading) of customer-collected information. All data is held in secure data centers with state of the art back-up and redundancy programs. Account data is password-protected, and only account holders can access these accounts. Survey Gizmo strives to meet all modern data security and privacy requirements, and is compliant and certified under both HIPAA (guidelines for the handling of medical information) and Safe Harbor (European Union privacy protection standards) programs.

The Coastal Commission will delete all records of any Personal Information collected within 14 days of the end of the CCD drawings unless the entrant opts to receive further communications. The California Coastal Commission will not sell or disclose Personal Information to any third parties. Personal Information collected by the California Coastal Commission is exempt from the provisions of the Public Records Act (Chapter 3.5 (commencing with section 6250) of Division 7 of Title 1). Any Personal Information acquired by the California Coastal Commission is subject to the limitations set forth in the Information Practices Act of 1977 (Title 1.8 (commencing with Section 1798) of Part 4 of Division 3 of the Civil Code).
